General Information

File Types - We accept the following file types and software files:

Resolution - Resolution, or "DPI," is the amount of dots or pixels per inch of an image. DPI is irrelevant in vector files - they can be sized up as large as necessary. If an image does not meet the required DPI for a specific custom product, one simply cannot add resolution to an image. It will render the image blurry and still unusable. If a submission does not meet our minimum require ments for DPI, it will be necessary to re-create an image with a higher DPI for the best possible image quality and output.

Poker Chip Case Engraving



- 4800 pixels in length
- 600 dpi
- Live area: 8" in length minimum
- Must use black and white -NO GRAYSCALE, NO COLOR, NO GRADIANT, NO HALF-TONES
- All our mahogany finish cases accept color filling; our oak cases do not.
- All aluminum cases can be customized by affixing a self-adhesive engraved or graphic plate to each case
